Cookie Policy

Present cookie policy applies to the website <u>https://www.kicom.be/</u> (hereinafter "Website"), owned and administrated by Ki' Communications (hereinafter «us», «we», «our»). Our website uses Cookies and similar technologies to improve your browsing experience, remember your preferences, provide you with personalized information, ensure your security, etc. In this Cookie Policy, you will find information on why we use cookies, how we use them, how you can control it.

1 What are cookies?

Cookies are small text files that a website saves on your computer or mobile device when you visit the site. The cookies will be used to remember your actions and preferences over a period of time, so you don't have to keep re-entering them whenever you come back to the site or browse from one page to another.

2 Why do we use cookies?

Ki' Communications uses the cookies that are necessary for the use of the Website, the cookies that allow us to improve your user experience and other cookies that collect statistical data on the use of the website.

The use of cookies requires your prior and explicit consent. If you refuse it, you will still be able to access the Website but you might not be able to enjoy certain features. You can always modify your choice.

Certain cookies are essential for the use of the Website or activation of specific features of the Website. The cookies necessary for ensuring the transmission of a communication or strictly necessary for providing for the function expressly requested by the user are exempted from the consent obligation.

We use the following types of cookies:

Strictly necessary cookies are required for the operation of our Website.

Performance cookies are necessary to count the number of visitors and see how they are using our Website. This helps us to improve your user experience.

Targeting cookies are used to provide you with more personalized advertisement.

Below you will find the full information on the type and purpose of each cookie used on our website.

3 How long will the cookies stay on my device? Do they expire?

Some cookies are only valid for the duration of your browsing session. They expire and are automatically deleted when you close your Internet browser, they are called session cookies.

Other cookies do not expire when you close your browser and are called "persistent" (permanent). They have a specified expiry period which is different for different types of cookies, and stay on your device between browsing sessions.

4 Are we using third-party cookies and aggregate information?

The cookies that are set to your device by a party other than Ki' communications, are called "third-party" cookies. Pages that contain embedded content like Youtube, may use the third parties cookies. Please consult the 3rd party websites for more information about their cookies.

We may also analyze aggregate and other information not identifying individual users in order to understand traffic patterns and improve your user experience.

5 Types of cookies used on our website

5.1 Strictly necessary cookies

These cookies are essential in order to enable the user to move around the website and use its features, such as accessing secure areas of the website. They are generally used to identify the user as unique to other users currently viewing the website in order to provide a consistent and accurate service to the user, for example, remembering previous actions (e.g. entered text) when navigating back to a page in the same session or maintaining tokens for the implementation of secure areas of the website.

5.2 Performance cookies

These cookies collect information about how visitors use a website, for instance which pages visitors go to most often, and if they get error messages from web pages. These cookies don't collect information that identifies a visitor. All information these cookies collect is aggregated and therefore anonymous. It is only used to improve how a website works. Can be used for Web analytics, ad response rates, error management.

5.3 Functionality cookies

These cookies allow the website to remember choices the user makes (such as preferred language or region) and provide enhanced, more personal features. They may also be used to provide services that the users have asked for such as watching a video or commenting on a blog. The information these cookies collect may be anonymized, and they cannot track the visitors' browsing activity on other websites. These cookies may be used to remember choices such as not to be asked again to fill in a questionnaire, or detecting if a service has been already offered.

5.4 Targeting cookies

These cookies are used to deliver adverts more relevant to the user and his interests. They are also used to limit the number of times user sees an advertisement as well as help measure the effectiveness of the advertising campaign. They remember that the users have visited a website and collect browsing habits in order to target relevant adverts to the user. Such cookies can also be used to increase functionality, such as enabling videos, sharing with social media, providing maps, etc.
